ESICHIA CHIANTI RISERVA 13,5% DOCG

Hesychasm (from Greek. Hesychasmos, from esychia, calm peace, absence of worry) is an ascetic doctrine and practice widespread among monks in the Christian East since the time of the Desert Fathers (4th century). A practice still widespread in the Orthodox world and in particular by the monks of Mount Athos.

Esichia is search for inner peace, in union with God and in harmony with the Creation Wine Chianti Riserva, made from more than 80% Sangiovese grapes and other international vines permitted by the production regulations. Ruby red in colour, tending to garnet and aged five years at least. Deep and intense on the nose with delicate notes of underbrush (blueberry, black cherry, morello cherry), complemented by pleasant floral scents. In the mouth it is enveloping, gritty and savoury with silky and elegant tannins. The finish is vibrant and very long.

We recommend a tasting that induces calm, almost interior recollection in order to savour the intrinsic characteristics of the wine. Goes well with grilled meat dishes, game, stews and aged cheeses.
